Quilt Preparation

- Quilt top should be trimmed down to final finished size. We will not cut or trim a quilt top.
- Check to ensure that all seams are secure. It is advisable to stay stitch around your entire quilt to ensure seams do not pull apart.
- Use a safety pin to mark the top of the quilt.
- Trim all excess threads. No embellishments should be applied to your quilt top until after quilting is completed.
- Quilt must be clean and free of odors.
- Quilt top and backing fabric must be completely pressed.
- Backing must be at least 8" larger than your quilt top and backing must be square.
- Quilt top and backing must be brought in as separate layers. Quilts previously sandwich will be separated and the customer will be charged an additional fee for this service.
- Batting must be purchased from Mira Stitch'n Post.
- We reserve the right to refuse unfamiliar backing fabrics such as bed sheets etc. We recommend that bed sheeting not be used as backing because the thread count of sheeting is not compatible with Quilters Cotton.
- If you pre-wash your fabrics in your quilt top it is highly recommended that you pre-wash your backing fabric also. If your backing fabric is purchased at the time of quilt drop of the Mira Stitch'n Post will wash and a fee of \$10 will be charged.
